
Colombia... Breathe Life

Arrival: Bogotá, Guatavita, Villa de leyva

Day 1 Hello Colombia!! Arrival at El Dorado airport in Bogotá. Transfer to hotel with welcome cocktail, dinner and overnight at the hotel

Day 2 Tour of the center of Bogotá, visit to the main energy, spiritual and sacred places of the Muiscas. Gastronomic show. Departure to Guatavita. Lunch. Visit to the lagoon guided by a Muisca descendant who will teach us the history of the territory, its ancestral symbology and its role in the balance of nature. Return to Bogotá. Dinner and night at the hotel

Day 3 Trip through "La sabana" towards Villa de Leyva. Stop at the bridge of Boyacá (Historical place – independence of Colombia). Lunch in town. Entrance to the municipality of Ráquira, famous for its typical handcrafts. Visit to the Muiscaobservatory. Return to Bogotá. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

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| | Day 4 | Visit Monserrate by funicular and / or Aerial lift. Lunch. Flight to Pereira, welcome cocktail and dinner in a typical restaurant. Overnight at the "Otún Quimbaya" Wildlife Sanctuary. |
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| | Day 5 | Introductory talk on the biodiversity of the area and nature photography course. Pastora's and the Cedral Walk (practical photography lesson). Lunch at the eco-shelter "La Pastora". Night walk. Dinner and overnight at the "Otun Quimbaya". |
| ALC: NO | Day 6 | Departure to plant endemic species trees. Lunch in a typical restaurant in Santa Rosa de Cabal. Visit and coffee tasting. Dinner and overnight at the "Otun Quimbaya" Wildlife Sanctuary |
| 1 | Day 7 | Departure to the Cocora Valley with lunch . Visit to Salento and transfer to the municipality of Apia. Dinner on the way in a typical restaurant. Welcome cocktail and overnight at the eco-inn "La Trinidad" |
| | Day 8 | Birdwatching in the natural park "Planes de San Rafael" Lunch in banana leaves (typical coffeeworker food). Walk to waterfalls. Dinner and overnight at the eco-inn "La Trinidad" |
| | Day 9 | Coffee experience in the Andrés Alzate and Flor de Apia fincas. Barismo and lunch in a typical restaurant. Dinner and overnight at the eco-inn "La Trinidad" |
| | Day 10 | Visit to Marsella and the botanical garden. Lunch. Free time. Canelazo and dinner in the San Rafael River with typical serenade. Overnight at the eco-inn " La Trinidad". |

Ocean, Jungle, beach and whales

| Day 11 | Flight from Pereira to Nuquí (Pacific coast). Trip through Nuquí with musical performance. Cocktail and Lunch . Transfer by boat to the island " El Morro de Terco". Dinner and overnight at the Eco touristic guesthouse of the island |
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| Day 12 | Visit to the thermals. Typical lunch . Visit and talk in the place where they protect the turtles. If the conditions allow it, liberation of the turtles at the beach. Dinner and overnight at the Eco touristic guesthouse of the island. |



Amazonas... Exuberant!

| Day 15 | Flight to Leticia – Amazonas and transfer to the Tanimboca natural reserve. Welcome-cocktail and lunch. Dinner and overnight at the tree hut (at 12 m high). Night walk (if conditions allow it). |
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| Day 16 | Etnotour: 09h00 departure through the jungle to the Huitoto or Macuna indigenous community. During this tour the artisanal fishing rods are prepared. Typical lunch. Talk with the Curaca, preparation of the Mambe, rape or Ambil and if conditions allow it, possibility of bathing in the Tacana waterfall. Dinner and overnight in the community, in hammocks / mattresses with mosquito net. Night of myths and legends into the maloca. |
| Day 17 | Transfer to "Mundo Amazónico", natural reserve. Visit to the ethno- botanical garden, the aquarium and visit to the cultural village of the different ethnic groups, where there are replicas of the malocas, traditional games (bow and arrow, darts, etc.). Process of Amazonian products (jams, aromatics, ointments, etc.), fruit tasting and trek through the jungle. In the afternoon, parrots watching in plaza santander. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Leticia |
| Day 18 | 07h30 Tour through the Amazon River. Wildlife watching. Visit to the reserve "Victoria Regia". Departure to Puerto Nariño with typical lunch . Arrival at the lakes of Tarapoto to pink dolphins watching. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Leticia. |

| Day 19 | Flight to Bogota. Lunch and free afternoon. Welcome-cocktail, dinner and overnight at the hotel. | |
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| Day 20 | Departure to Zipaquirá with lunch in a typical restaurant. Entrance to the Salt Cathedral. Farewell party with typical dinner and local music. Overnight hotel | |
